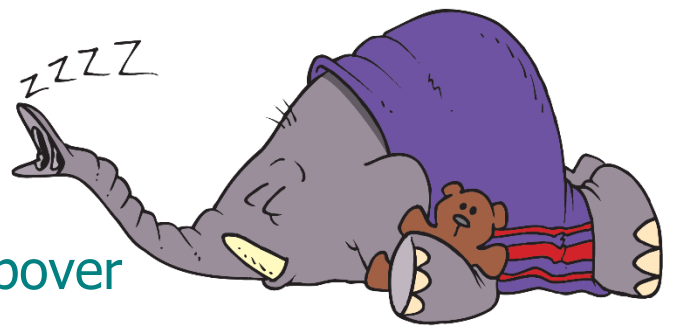

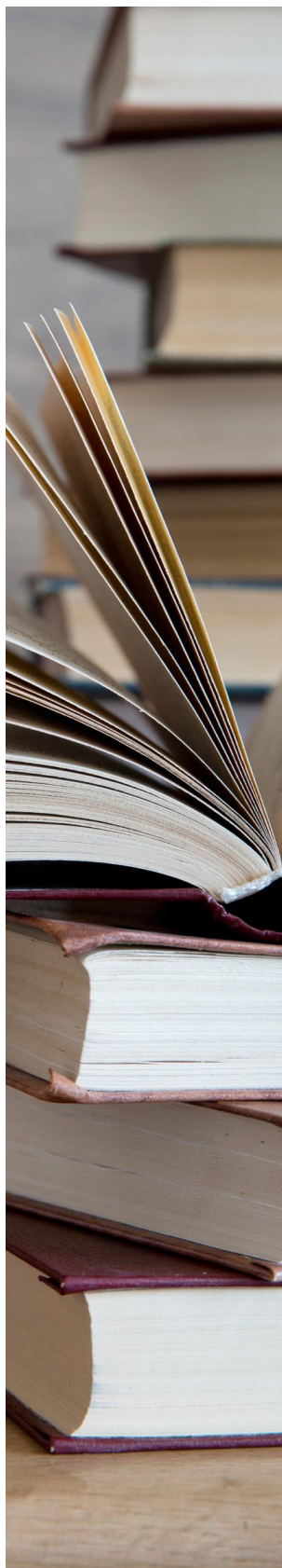
At RML, we are celebrating on Saturday, November

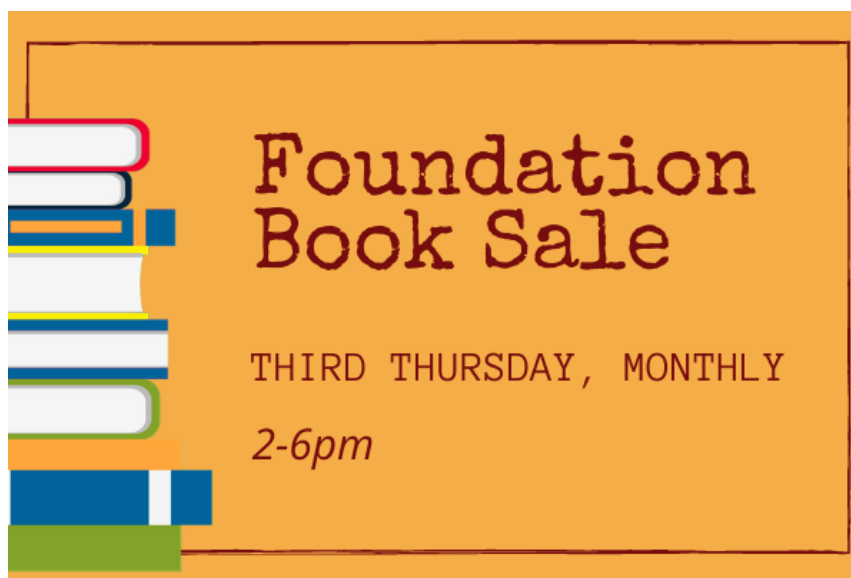
Thursday Night Book Club

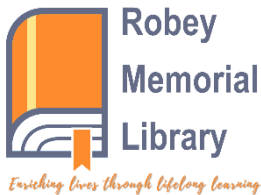
