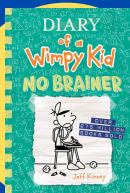

When her missing mom reappears during a true crime doc, Bel seeks the truth behind her return.



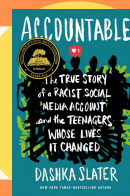
Tre chases his late brother's dream, leading his rez team to state while finding his own path forward.
